VCom and the Pool Join Forces to Expand High-Speed Technology in Saskatchewan

September 7, 2006 - VCom Inc. (TSX: VCM) and Saskatchewan Wheat Pool Inc. (TSX: SWP) today announced the establishment of a long-term strategic relationship to expand high-speed technology to the Pool, its farm customers and communities throughout the Province of Saskatchewan.

YourLink Inc., VCom's subsidiary Internet service provision company, and the Pool have entered into a 7-year agreement to extend YourLink's wireless network coverage to over 100 of the Pool's grain marketing and agri-product centres across Saskatchewan. Combining VCom's top-selling Broadband Wireless Internet Network (BWIN) and newly developed WiMAX systems, YourLink will provide high-speed, wireless broadband service to the Pool's Saskatchewan network.

As part of the agreement, many of the Pool's sites will also become high-speed wireless access points that are expected to add several thousand subscribers to YourLink's Saskatchewan base and generate \$8 million in YourLink revenue over the life of the agreement. Targeting farms and small communities within range of the Pool's locations, YourLink will be able to provide high speed Internet services to a large area of Saskatchewan beyond the areas already covered by its extensive tower network.

"The Pool's grain handling network and strategically located agri-products facilities are a natural fit as access points," said VCom Chairman and Chief Executive Dr. Surinder Kumar. "The height and centrality of these locations presents the strategic opportunity to provide Internet services to farms, businesses and residents in neighbouring areas."

As one of the largest companies in the Province of Saskatchewan and a significant contributor to the economic fabric of rural communities, the Pool is expanding its commitment to agriculture through this initiative. It is the first step in a comprehensive strategy being employed by the Pool that will position its growers with the technology and access to the real-time information they require to maximize their marketing opportunities and compete in the global marketplace.

President and CEO Mayo Schmidt said, "This relationship brings value to our operations by improving network performance and allowing us to manage costs over the long-term. Our partnership allows the Pool to contribute to the expansion of high-speed wireless capabilities within Saskatchewan while offering our customers new solution-based technology that will improve the efficiency of their farming operations. It is this type of innovation that the Pool will continue to provide to ensure that western Canadian farmers have the tools they need to compete."

YourLink also plans high-performance WiMAX installations beginning this fall in urban communities around Saskatchewan. This will be the first commercial deployment of VCom's new WiMAX product in Canada and will provide regional Saskatchewan cities and businesses with advanced data services previously available only in large centres.

Headquartered in Saskatoon, Canada and providing broadband communications to BC, Alberta, Saskatchewan and Ontario, YourLink provides innovative high-speed wireless Internet solutions and cable television services to residential and business subscribers across Canada. YourLink was formed in 2003 to deploy Saskatchewan designed and manufactured equipment from VCom Inc. YourLink is also offering NetCall, a bundled VoIP service utilizing low-cost, full-featured inexpensive long distance and voice-over Internet Protocol (VoIP) second line telephone services to its entire operating area.

YourLink's wireless network brings broadband Internet service to rural areas and small communities outside the range of traditional cable or telco DSL service. Prior to the introduction of broadband wireless, many rural residents could only access the Internet through dial-up telephone lines. Internet service via traditional cable is not feasible in sparsely populated regions, and satellite services have too much delay for many Internet applications.
